Yarns, threads as well as hand knitting and handcraft yarns made of polyester (incl. Trevira® CS), acrylic, polyamide, polypropylene, viscose, lyocell (LENZING™ Lyocell), cotton, linen, ramie, wool, silk, modacryl (Kanecaron®, PyroTex®), meta-aramide (Nomex®, Euramid®), para-aramide (Twaron®, Technora®), elastane, PPS (polyphenylene sulphide) and antistatic fibres (Bekinox®, Belltron®, Nega-Stat®, No-Shock®, Resistat®) pure and/or in blends, white and dyed, (partly) produced with fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties; produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®. Note: Various tested fibres may contain more than 0,1 % (but max. 3.0 %) of NMP, DMAc or DMF and have to undergo further industrial production stages (heat process in wet or dry stage is preferred, but also other steps are possible). Afterwards new tests for the presence of NMP, DMAc and DMF (max. 0,1 %) are obligatory.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.

The certificate A10-0898 is valid until 31.01.2022
